### PROJECT EXPERIENCE

#### Coventry Destination Leisure and Water Facility

Lead Project Manager for a new £36m destination leisure water centre project in the centre of Coventry. The project is a major redevelopment that will kick start regeneration of the city centre south area by helping to increase and retain footfall in this area of the centre. The project is also a key component of Coventry's leisure strategy and vision. The design has a lot of challenges in terms of complexities of design and programming and phasing the work.

#### Palace of Westminster Restoration and Renewal Programme

Lead Programme Manager on the initial phase of this multi-billion pound restoration programme. Peter was responsible for running a team of thirty personnel on a client site for eight months. The team delivered an Independent Options Appraisal outlining how the Palace could be restored and renewed, including developing the brief for the works.

#### Coventry 50m Pool

Lead Project Manager for a new £13m 50m pool development in the South East of Coventry. The project comprises a major remodelling and refurbishment of an existing dry side centre to provide a new 50m swimming pool

in the existing indoor football hall, a larger fitness suite, additional function room space and new office accommodation. Tasks undertaken on this project include project management, design management, procurement and stakeholder engagement, as well as working closely with the operator, Coventry Sports Foundation.

#### Broadbridge Heath Leisure Centre, Horsham

Project Director on a new leisure centre in Horsham, West Sussex. Responsible for managing a team of consultants delivering a new build leisure centre on a constrained site with two adjacent operational buildings.

#### Queens Park Sports Centre, Chesterfield

Lead Project Manager responsible for the construction phase of a new leisure centre in a listed park in Chesterfield. Facilities include an eight lane 25m pool, learner pool, eight court sports hall, squash courts, midwifery, exercise studios and multi-use training rooms to be used by the local college. This was all built on a challenging site with live badgers setts and historic underground mine shafts.

#### Splashpoint Leisure Centre, Worthing

Lead Project Manager for a new leisure centre in Worthing. This iconic building designed by Wilkinson Eyre is heralded as a gateway building for Worthing. It is located adjacent to a Grade II\* Listed Building and was constructed whilst keeping the old leisure centre open. Facilities include a 25m 6-lane competition swimming pool, learner / diving pool, leisure water and slides, outdoor pools, 100 station fitness suite, dance studios, café, external sun terrace and beach front kiosk.
